SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2025

Sarina State High School is offering twelve (12) scholarships, for students who are attending our school in 2025.

Scholarships at our school will be presented in the following categories:

- Four (4) for Academic Excellence
- Four (4) for Citizen/Leadership Excellence or Cultural Excellence
- Four (4) for Sporting, Rugby League or Netball Excellence

Criteria

Applicants must attend a primary school in the Sarina Cluster in Year 6 and be recommended by their primary school for the nominated scholarship. Scholarship holders will receive their benefits in Year 7 at Sarina State High School, provided they abide by Sarina State High School's Student Code of Conduct, and maintain the excellence for which they were chosen.

Guidelines

Scholarship applications will be processed by an independent panel at our school and the recipient's will be notified once the process is completed. A scholarship will entitle the student to **\$200** towards any educational expense incurred during the first year of attendance at Sarina State High School.

Additional information

- All applications must be in the students handwriting.
- Applicants may select one or more scholarships, and be considered for those categories. Successful applicants will only be awarded one scholarship.
- All applications will be kept confidential.
- Recipients of the scholarships will be notified by telephone and mail, while unsuccessful applicants will be notified by mail.
- Recipients of the scholarships will be advertised in Sarina State High School publications as well as in the local community.

Year 7 Scholarship Application

Criteria	Explanation
Conduct – for all scholarships	Your conduct in the classroom and playground must be excellent at all times.
Academic Scholarship	You must demonstrate a very high level of academic achievement as shown by your report card and certificates or prizes for academic competitions such as the McDonald's Mathematics Team Challenge.
Citizenship/Leadership Scholarship	You must demonstrate that you are a positive role model to your peers. Please outline your leadership role at your school e.g. school captain, captain of sports team, leadership positions within your classroom, participation in school and community activities e.g. fundraising, volunteering.
Cultural Scholarship	You have demonstrated a high level of selection or participation in your chosen field or creative arts e.g. Grade 5 Speech or Eisteddfod Section prize and participation in school curriculum and extra-curricular activities e.g. Rock Pop Mime, school band.
Sporting Scholarship	You have demonstrated a high level of selection e.g. Mackay and District, for your chosen sport and participation in school carnivals.
Rugby League Scholarship	You have demonstrated a high level of selection e.g. Mackay and District for rugby league and participation in school carnivals.
Netball Scholarship	You have demonstrated a high level of selection e.g. Mackay and District for netball and participation in school carnivals.

Please attach your Year 6 Semester One Report Card and any other relevant certificates or information.

Include additional statements from up to two referees to support your application, this may be your specialist teacher, coach or someone from the community.
