- ensure all Year 12 students exit school with a suitable pathway – QCE / QCIA and/or ATAR and VET qualification;
- improve the literacy outcomes (reading and writing) of all students;
- deliver high quality teaching in every classroom every day across the school;
- improve whole school attendance.

Our initiatives include

- quality assure the curriculum in a consistent approach to curriculum delivery through whole school moderation, alignment, planning and assessment;
- strengthen the case management and tracking approach for all students from Years 7 -12;
- develop a whole school approach to teaching literacy to support teaching across all learning areas;
- refine the school pedagogical framework and provide professional development for all staff to increase capability to initiate and implement innovative practices in and beyond the classroom;
- build teacher capability to differentiate and improve learning outcomes for all students;
- identify and extend high performing students across all learning areas, in particular science, technologies, engineering and mathematics (STEM);
- enhance the use of digital pedagogies across the curriculum.

Employing a Speech Pathologist (0.4) to support students and to support staff in the implementation whole school literacy programs	\$37 000

Providing human resources to provide support to students and teachers	\$180 000
