

Service awards are awarded to students who have performed **significant service** to the school community in the past 12 months. The following are criteria which are considered when selection of service awards are made. **All year levels are eligible for this award.**

The service would

- have taken place over a period of time
- have benefited a significant group of the school community
- not have interfered with the school's normal expectation of a student

Examples of service include:

- Involvement in Student Council (in the roles of School Captain, Vice Captains, Executive Committee, Year Level Representatives, etc.)
- House Captain
- Interact
- Assistance in tuckshop
- Rewards Days Organisation
- Assisting at Year 12 Formal
- Peer Mediation
- School Band

- Involvement in Cadets
- Marching in ANZAC Parade
- Buddies
- School Magazine
- Co-ordination of Parades
- Positive Postcard Designer
- Subject Selection Evenings
- Enrolment Evenings
- Events catering (eg. NAPLAN, External Exams breakfast)
