- Deliver high quality teaching practices in every classroom, every day across the whole school.
- Deliver high quality curriculum in every classroom, every day across the whole school.
- Improve student engagement – attendance, wellbeing, behaviour, case management.

## Our initiatives include

- Continuing to quality assure the curriculum in a consistent approach to curriculum delivery through alignment, planning, assessment and moderation.
- Strengthening case management and data tracking from Years 7 to Year 12.
- Developing the whole school approach to literacy to support the consistent teaching of literacy and numeracy across all learning areas.
- Refining the school pedagogical framework and providing professional development for all staff.
- Building teaching capability to differentiate and improve learning outcomes for all students.
- Identifying and extending high performing students across all learning areas, particularly in STEM.
- Continued use and development of digital pedagogies.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Developing innovative student resources and programs across curriculum areas: **\$ 80 000**
- Providing whole school data tracking resources and testing: **\$ 10 000**
- Providing support to student and staff for transition programs: **\$ 20 000**
- Providing professional development for staff to deliver high quality teaching practices including STEM and digital pedagogies: **\$ 30 000**
- Employing a Speech Pathologist to support students and staff: **\$ 37 000**
- Supporting student and staff wellbeing: **\$ 35 000**
- Providing human resources to provide support to students and teachers: **\$ 200 000**
- Developing whole school curriculum planning and professional development for staff: **\$ 20 463**
